**Youth basketball (Grades K-4)**

**The fundamentals of basketball, with the accent on "fun!"**

Boys and girls will learn the game best through playing it. We emphasize developing skills, practicing sportsmanship, and being a team member. Every child plays at least two quarters of every game. Scorekeeping is not allowed. First quarter of every game is practice. One 50-minute game per week; no other practices. Spectator seating is not available at all locations; you may wish to bring a chair.

Basketball Atlantic and Central divisions use junior-sized basketballs (27½") and 8-foot standards. Pacific division uses intermediate basketballs and 10-foot standards. No full-court press. If you wish to have your child placed with a friend or assigned to a particular manager, note it on the designated space on the registration form. We'll do our best to honor your request. Brothers and sisters registered in the same program are placed on the same team, unless you request otherwise; the same goes for managers and their children. We do not accept registration by complete teams. You will receive a confirmation by mail the week before games start with your team number and game time. The first week will be "Meet the Manager" day, when your participant will get acquainted with teammates and team managers, and they will receive their t-shirt and schedule. Games will begin the second week. There are no hidden costs in the program. Game admission is free, and we do not hold fundraisers.
